Kelly Root, vice president of sales for Louisiana-based Capitol Welders, called the education and training at the Specialty Gas Institute invaluable. “Finally, specialty gas producers have a school that addresses real world production problems, presented by someone with real world production experience,” Root said.

The October and December classes are full, but CryoVation is taking reservations for Institutes scheduled March 15-19 and June 21-25, 2010. For companies that offer medical gas services, CryoVation, LLC also holds a semi-annual FDA Compliance Seminar. The seminar focuses on Current Good Manufacturing Practices (CGMP) and meets documented training requirements of 21 CFR 211.25.
